WELDER PROGRAM

EXPLANATION OF FORMS 200, 300, AND 400

1. **Welding Process** – Show the process for which the applicant was tested. Refer to “Welder Certification” in WABO Standard No. 27-13.
 - **Manual** – welder controls the electrode, as in SMAW and GTAW
 - **Semiautomatic** – welder holds equipment, but electrode is machine fed, as in GMAW and FCAW
 - **Automatic** – welding operator sets the machine which is mechanized or fully automatic
2. **Stamp No.** – Show the welder/welder operator identification mark which is stamped on the test weldment.
3. **WPS No.** – Show the Welding Procedure Specification number that your facility has assigned.
4. **Material** – Fill in weldment test criteria from the information provided in the *List of Tables* found in WABO Standard No. 27-13
5. **Test Results (weldment)** – Record the findings of Visual, Bend, Radiographic, or Macro Etch tests.
6. **Test Witnessed By** – **Print name** of the WABO approved welder examiner witnessing the test, record test date and sign.
7. **Test Conducted By** – **Print name** of the WABO approved welder examiner conducting the test, record test date and sign.
8. **Certification of Statements**
 - a. **Welder Qualifying Agency** – enter name of the WABO approved agency, (in the case of agencies with multiple WABO approved locations – **provide the agency location** in addition to the agency name).
 - b. **By** – Agency WABO approved welder examiner or welder agency “contact” person signs and dates the form.

NOTE: If an applicant’s test weldment fails, a copy of the Performance Qualification Test Record Form No. 200/300 shall become a permanent part of the applicant’s test record retained by the agency. Follow the “RETEST” procedures found in WABO Standard No. 27-13.
